The Superintendent shall manage all aspects of the sewer and drainage collection system including Capacity Management, Operations, and Maintenance Program (CMOM); Sanitary Sewer Overflow Emergency Response Plan (SSO ERP); regulatory reporting in accordance with DEP and EPA; manage budgetary functions; prepare specifications, pre-requisitions and reports; oversee personnel and labor relations; implement directives of the Commission; review and approve invoices; recommend and implement long-term capital improvements; assist with the purchasing of sewer equipment/supplies; assign and schedule daily work orders; prepare all reporting requirements under the Commission's Consent Decree which includes the Annual and Quarterly reports; and perform any/all other management responsibility tasks of the Commission.

Minimum Requirements: Associate's Degree in Civil Engineering or related field. A minimum of five (5) years' experience in public administration as a manager/supervisor of a municipal sewer and drainage collection system. Knowledge of all technical phases of sewer and drainage collection, public health and environmental regulations and the ability to interpret engineering plans. A proven track record to effectively communicate both orally and in writing; including, but not limited to, communication with the public, regulatory agencies, contractors and employees. Ability to update drawings, GIS data base, prepare plans, sketches and cost estimates for in-house sewer and drain projects.

Hold and maintain all required licenses pertaining to the job, including a Massachusetts Commercial Driver's License, Massachusetts Department of Public Safety Hoisting License, and Massachusetts Grade IV Collection System Certification. Ability to use Computerized Maintenance Management System.
