**6/8** 10-12 Central Ave to Andrew St at Market St, Munroe St at Market St to Mt. Vernon St, opposite 15 Andrew St to 198 Oxford St, Blake St opposite Almont St to Essex St to Sutton St.

**6/9** 31 North Common St to Franklin St to N Franklin, Franklin St at Western Ave to 19 Harwood St, 527 Western Ave to 65 Mall St, 33 Whiting St to Park St at Bennett Cir.

**6/10** 22 Endicott St to 32 Whittier St, 12 Nichols Ave to Liberty at Willow St, 56 Johnson St to 182 Washington St, Washington St at Hamilton to Liberty St at Buffum St.

Rusty and dirty water may be experienced for a short time during and after flushing. If the water appears dirty, leaving the tap open for several minutes following should clear the pipes. Prior to doing laundry, residents are advised to check this schedule. This program is necessary to clean the distribution system of residual materials that normally settle out in the mains during the year so as to ensure the delivery of better quality water during the coming summer months.
